“Public Safety State of the Community” – Lt. Jim Rudy

- Jim has been assigned to Ladera for 2 years. Unincorporated areas he's in charge of.
- Staffing...1 lieutenant, 3.5 sergeants, 2 investigators, 20 Deputies, 1 CSO, \$6M ...cso budget.
- 27 square miles, 55,000 people. Coto, Ladera, Las Flores, Wagon Wheel, Trabuco Canyon and different parks, Caspers, Ortega, HWY, Holy Jim Canyon, Cleveland Joplin and Blue Jay.
 - Ladera 23,000 5 square miles, 7,100 homes.
- Michael asked Robbery vs. Burglary...Robbery is forcibly taking possession from the person from force or fear. Only 5 in 2012...60 Burglaries in 2012.
- Roger asked if there are seasonal issues. Summer is heavier.
 - People steal stuff out of cars because they know people don't take stuff inside...people check cars if they are unlocked. They work with 24 hour to force people to show id's when setting up an account as people were taking id's and setting up accounts.
- 2009 3,885 total of P1,P2, and P3
 - P is Priority 1,2, and 3
 - P3 isn't that much of a priority...it's more of just a report call. P1 is sirens and getting there quickly.
- Timing
 - 7-9 minutes response time for P1's. Their goal is 6 minutes.
- Rancho Mission Viejo developing 6,000 acres at Ortega and Antonio.
 - Village of Sendoro opening summer of 2013.
 - Sendoro - 690 acres, 940 homes. 200 apartment units, 10 acre retail plaza
- Question if they were adding people...nothing tangible as of yet, but Jett explained that we are the watchdogs of the conduit to look at getting more resources. Person from audience wanted to make sure we were supporting and lobbying not just for citizen safety, but safety of the officers themselves. Lt. Rudy expressed that we also get support from RSM to assist as well as MV on events. Discussed the example last week in the murder that occurred in Ladera that continued onto Tustin.
- Question came on the Mello Roos and Jett explained that it's a separate element and not part of Mello Roos
